Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog Class: To be entered in Stud Dog Class and shown with two (2) or more of his get. Get need not be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes. Awards will be entirely on the merits of the get. As the Judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed (Variety) by virtue of having won this class. Brood Bitch Class: Same as above, except for the following two changes: Substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog", and substitute "Produce" for "Get".

Brace Class: This shall be for two dogs with identical ownership. Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If entered for Brace Class Only full particulars must be given for each dog entered on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes.

NON-REGULAR (NON-COMPETITIVE) CLASSES

PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS is for dogs that are American Champions, Field Trial Champions, AKC Obedience Title Holders and dogs that have earned a Working Dog Title from the AKC. Parade MUST be indicated on the entry form. All entrants receive a Rosette with the dog's names imprinted in gold.

Stripped Down Competition shall be offered for any AJC Champion of Record (Conformation) of any age or Variety. Length of hair is required to be trimmed to a maximum of 1 ½ inches long on any portion of the body, with the exception of the ears where no length restrictions apply. Entrants are to be judged on conformation. All varieties of dogs (males) will be judged first as one class, then all varieties of bitches will be judged as the second class. The winners of these two respective classes will compete for Best in Stripped Competition. Judging will begin following completion of the Puppy Sweepstakes and prior to the beginning of the Regular classes. Entrants in this special competition will not be required to compete for Best of Variety. If further competition is desired (i.e. Best of Variety, Best Stud Dog, or Best Brood Bitch) an "Additional Entry of Same Dog" fee shall be required.

INTERMEDIATE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys or Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys or Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.
